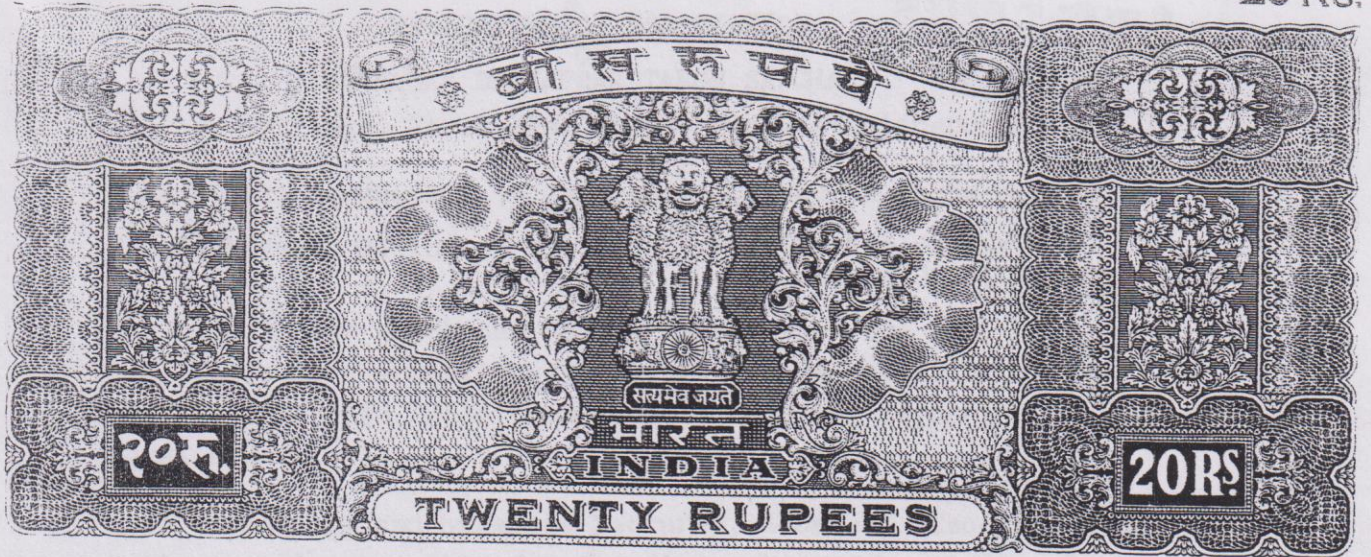

1. Name of the Sangha : Jararnagar Deshapran Tarun Sangha.
2. The Registered Office of the Sangha : Vill. Jararnagar,  
P.O. Henria, Dist. Midnapore.
3. The objects for which the Sangha established are :
  - a) To acquire establish start, aid run, maintain or manage schools, libraries, Hospitals for the benefits of Sangha of rural areas.
  - b) To arrange and organise lectures, debates, discussions Seminars and excursions for the discussion of knowledge of the members.
  - c) To publish the useful literatures magazines, books etc.
  - d) To study cultivate and demonstrate the art of music and sancing.
  - e) To help the needy students (firls) of all communities for the prosecution of studies.
  - f) To collect donations, subscriptions and for the purpose of the Jararnagar Deshapran Tarun Sangha.
  - g) To construct, maintain, improve and develop, alter any buildings, houses, or ~~an~~ other works necessary or convenient for the purpose of the Sangha.
  - h) To help poor and needy child for the child welfare.
  - i) To adopt the all sorts of the Schemes for the Welfare of the Children given or supported by the authorityx i.e. State e Council for child welfare, Indian Council for child welfare, or any other Organisation of native and foreign lands.
  - j) To arrange sports and games to encourage village young boyes for the development of the Rural health.
  - k) To help aged, sick, helpless and indigent boyes.
  - l) To take necessary steps for improved method of cultivation, poultry, farming, Goat-rearing, Pisciculture, Dairy, fish-schemes of State and Central Social Welfare Advisory Board for the develop-ment of needy poor men.

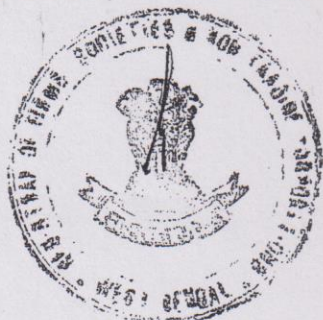

- m) To start a Sishukalyan Bivag for the development of handicapped or Pratibandhi.
- n) To do all such things as may deemed incidental or conductive to the attainment of the foregoing objects.
- o) To arrange 'Night School' for the aradication of illiteracy of the men in the society without distinction of any caste and creed.
- p) To arrange small scale Industries for ameliorating of beggary among the men (such as Biri making, Thongs paper making works, Mat Industry , and handloom and all other small scale Industries of Statē Govt.
- q) To take all sorts of the Khadi works supported by the Khadi Commission of the Govt.
- r) To start movement against the 'Pana Pratha' dowry System, Suti Rite, 'Satidaha' and 'Parda Nasin' that are the scandals of the womens society of our country.
- s) To start orphange of poor and destitute girls.
- t) To adopt all sorts of schemes of Central Social Welfare Board for the Welfare of the women of our area and for the children of working ailing & needy women's Children of our area.
- u) To start the camps for the welfare of poor women from the Family phanning Dept. of the Health Department of the Govt.
- v) The Arrange a Mahila Samiti.
- w) To start non-formal education Centre of unschooled children, and Balwodi Scheme for minor children Creche schemes of Central and State level.
- x) So make relations with the Philanthropic organisation like - Ramkrishna Mission and other foreign Philanthropic ortanisation and with the Govt. (Both state and Central.)

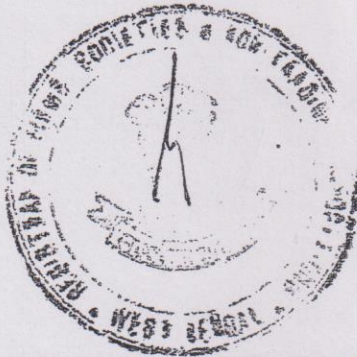

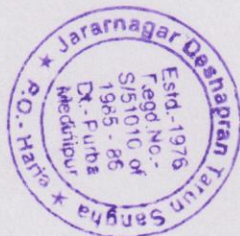

Regulation of Association.  
of  
Jararnagar Deshapran Tarun Sangha.

Membership :

1. Qualification of admission -

The following member are eligible for membership of the Jararnagar Deshapran Tarun Sangha.

a) Any member who attended the age of 16 years and who agrees in writing to be bound by the memorandum and regulations of the sangha.

b) Any society or Institution of club whose objects are similar to those of the Sangha will be represented by the Secretary or any person duly authorised on that behalf.

2. Classof members :-

- a) Fondar (b) Donor (c) Ordinary (d) Life member  
e) Institutional member (f) Honorary member.

a) Fonder member :- The following member are to be the founder members of the Sangha and will remain so till life and will be entitled to all rights and privileges of membership.

b) Donor :- Any person, Institution society incorporated company, qualified to be a member by paying or having paid some of Rupees 100/- (One hundred) or endowing moveable or immovable property Rs. 100/- or above may be admitted as a donor member by the Executive Committee.

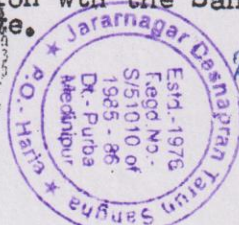
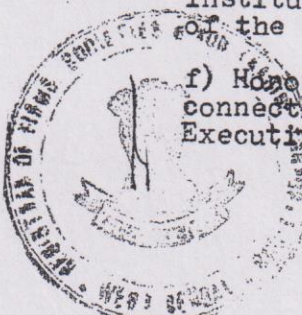
c) Life member :- Any person, Institution, society or incorporated company, qualified to be a member by paying or having paid a sum of Rupees 250/- (Rupees two hundred and fifty) or endowing movable or immovable properties worth Rupees 250/- or above may admitted as a life member b the executive committee.

d) Ordinary member :- Any person, qualified to be a member paying membership fee Rs. 1/- may be admitted as ordinary member of the Sangha with a monthly Rs. 0.25 per month.

member

e) Institution :- Any institution or society can be a member with membership fee of Rs. 2.00 with a monthly fee Rs. 1.00 in case of exchange of books and other fee of Rs. 1.00. In case of articles, the institutions member should execute an agreement as per direction of the executive committee of the Sangha.

f) Honorary member :- Any person qualified to be a member whose connection with the Sangha is deemed to be necessary by the Executive.

members. He may not be eligible to be member of the executive committee nor shall be entitled to vote at any meeting.

Cessation of the membership :-

Any member shall cease to be a member :-

- a) On resignation from membership by a letter or addressed to the Secretary.
- b) On his becoming insane or insolvency.
- c) On his conviction of any offence in connection with the information, promotion, management of conduct of affairs of society or of a body corporate or of any offence involving moral turpitude and no pay subscription with the prescribed time.

4. Register of members :-

The Sangha shall maintain a register of members containing the name, father's name, address age and their occupations date of admission and the date of cessation. The Register will be kept open for inspection of members of the Sangha.

5. Right and obligations of members :-

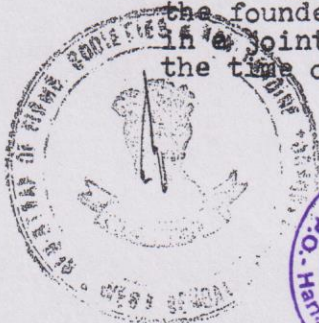
- a) Any member of the Sangha has the right to elect or to be elected in any election of the Sangha to be held in due time.
- b) To submit suggestion for discussion to the executive body and sub-committee on any matter.
- c) To inspect the accounts of the Sangha on appointment with the Executive Body.
- d) To forego his membership after due information in writing to the Executive Body.
- e) To pay his subscriptions within the prescribed time.
- f) Defaulting members shall not be allowed to take part or tute in a meeting.

Executive Committee :

There shall be an Executive Committee consisting of not less than 7(seven) and not more than 11(Eleven) and will be composed of the-three founder members, 1(One donor) member 1(one) life member 4(four) elected members.

The elected members shall be elected at the annual general meeting of the Sangha in every three years. Elected members can be a member of the Executive Committee for consecutive three terms after three terms compulsory retirement is necessary. In case of the founder members will be selected for the executive Committee in the joint meeting amongst themselves in every 5(five) years at the time of reconstitution of the Executive Committee.

The Office bearers of the executive committee shall consist of the President, Vice-President, Secretary, Asstt. Secretary, and treasurer.

The Office bearers shall be elected the Executive Committee from amongst themselves. The executive body has the power to co-opt any member when occasion arises.

2. Termination of membership :-

If member of the Executive Body shall cease to be a member of the Executive body if-he resigns by alter addressed to the Secretary (b) He absents himself from three consecutive meetings of the Sangha. (c) He is convicted of any offence in connection with the formation, promotion, management or conduct of the affairs of a society or of a body corporate or of any offence involving moral turpitude.

3. M E E T I N G S :-

A meeting of the Executive Committee shall be held at least once in three months at such place and time as the president or the Secretary may determine. One third of the total members of the Executive Body will form quorum. Any four members of the Executive Body may requisition the meeting of the Executive Body and the Secretary shall summon the same within 7 days and failing which the president or the requisitionists is to may do so provided no business other than the specified in the notice shall be transacted at such meeting.

4. N O T I C E :-

7 (seven) days notice of the meeting specifying the place, time and the general nature of work and business to be transacted shall be given to every members of the Executive Body. Emergency meeting may be called 24 (twentyfour) hours notice. These members personally present shall constitute a quorum for the meeting and if a quorum is not present within 30 minutes of the time the members present may adjourn the meeting.

5. Prodedure of the meeting :-

The president in his absence, the vicepresident shall preside over all the meetings of the executive body and in their absence members present shall elect a chairman of the meeting. All questions before the meeting will be decided by a majority of votes each member having one vote. The President or the Chairman shall have a second or casting vote in addition to his own vote in case of equality of votes. The President or Chairman while presiding at the meeting of the Executive body shall decide all questions relating to the constitution or rules and regulations thereof and his decision shall be final and binding.

6. Power and duties of the Executive Body :

The Executive Body shall have the power or supervision and conduct over all the affairs of the Sangha and in particular shall discharge the following duties :-

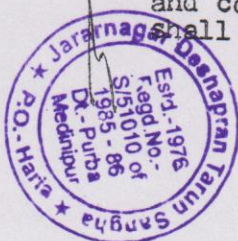

- 1) To summon the annual general meeting of the Sangha.
- ii) To appoint sub-committee with such power and duties as may be considered necessary or expedient.
- iii) To except donations, gift, subscription movable or immovable property for the objects of the Sangha.
- iv) To sell, lease, mortgage or otherwise despose of and deal with all or any part of the property of the Sangha as deemed necessary for expedient for his purpose of the Sangha.
- v) To keep proper accounts of the Sangha and to open Bank account in the name of the Sangha in one or more of the Schedules Bank. X Bank accounts will be operated by the president jointly with the Secretary or treasurer or as desired by the executive body.

Safe-custody of funds :-

- 1) The Executive Body of the Sangha shall be responsible for the safe custody of the funds and assets of the organisation.
- ii) The funds of the Sangha shall be kept in some Schedule Bank and be invested in any securities specified under section 20 of the Indian Trust Act. 1882.

Book and accounts & inspections :-

The books of accounts and other statutory books shall be kept at the Registered Office and shall be open to inspection of the members of the executive body during usual office hours and the same shall be open to inspection of the members at such time and place, and the executive body directs on a written request made by any member.

The books of accounts shall be audited by qualified Auditors.

Accounting Year :-

The Accounting year of the Sangha shall be April to March.

General Meeting :-

There shall be two kinds or general meeting.

1) (a) Annual (b) Special or Extra-ordinary.

(2) The Sangha shall held an annual General Meeting at least once in every year and not more than 15 months shall elapse between successive annual general meeting. At least 14 days notice specifying the time place and the day and hour shall be given to every member of the organisation.

3. The quorum for the transaction of any business, shall be one third of the total number of members in the Register present personally or by proxy in the case of an institutional member.

4. The business to be transacted in the annual general meeting.  
a) To confirm the minutes of the last general meeting and of special general meetings if any.

b) To adopt with or without modifications the report of the working of the Sangha for the previous year ended.

c) To pass audited accounts for the said year and to approve the budget estimate.

d) To appoint qualified auditor or auditors to be elected four members to the Executive Body amongst the subscribing members (ordinary member).

Election :-

4. (i) The election will be conducted by joint electorate system.

ii) Representatives of all categories will be elected from the respective category.

(iii) The election will be conducted just like the general election system by the Executive Body or as desired by the Governing Body which will be approved by the General Meeting.

(iv) No member can take part in the election before the completion of one year as membership.

5. A special general meeting shall be convened by the Secretary if two thirds members of the Sangha requisitioned such meeting on receipt of such notice the Secretary shall hold such meeting within 21 days. In default by the Secretary, the requisitionists shall hold such meetings provided no business other than that specified in the notice shall be transacted.

Duty of Office bearers :-

1. President :-

(a) He shall preside over all meetings of the Sangha.

(b) Advise the Sangha on all points of disputes and generally look after the interest of the Sangha.

(c) Take all disciplinary actions such as removal dismissal etc. in consultation with the Governing Body.

2. Secretary :-

(a) She is the Head of the Executive Body and of the Sangha.

(b) He shall convene all meetings of the Sangha.

(c) Maintain minute books of all meetings.

(d) Issue general circulars and notices.

(e) Issue appointment letters to the staff.

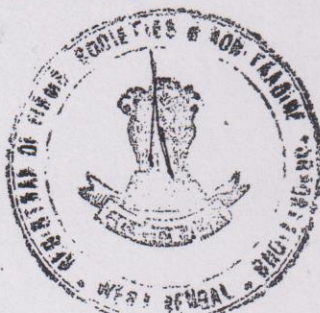
(f) Receives all applications for membership of the Sangha, which shall be placed before the Executive Body.

(g) Sign and give pay order on the bills for payments.

(h) Transport all other business as per direction of the Executive Body.

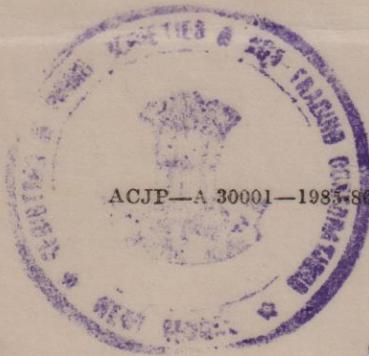
